**Return from Suspension of Trading of Shares on PLUS
& Correction of AGM Statement**

Further to the announcement of 6 June 2012 and following the publication of the Company's final results for the year to 31 December 2011, the Company's convertible redeemable £1 preference shares and ordinary 0.8p shares resumed trading on PLUS SX Quoted Market with effect from 28 June 2012.

The announcement made on 28 June 2012 entitled "Notice of AGM" contained an error. In the "Extracts of Circular", the wording for section "[12. Recommendation](#)" should read:

"The Board believes that the passing of the Resolutions are in the best interests of the Company and its shareholders as a whole. The Directors, other than Mr L Bechis, who abstained from voting, recommend that you vote in favour of the Resolutions. The Directors, other than Mr L Bechis who abstained from declaring his intention, intend to vote in favour in respect of their own beneficial shareholdings or those they control."
